

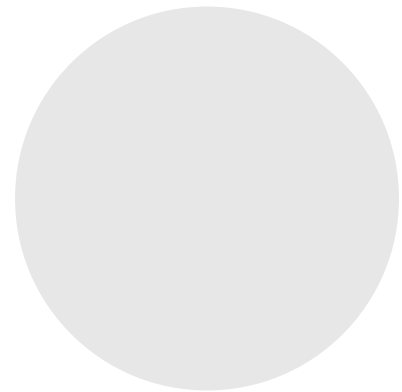

Biography

Donna Blois worked as counsel for the Department of Justice from 1998 to 2015. During that time, she held positions in various legal services, working on behalf of clients such as the Commissioner of Competition, Global Affairs Canada, and the Communications Security Establishment. During her tenure as counsel, Donna worked on several high-profile national security matters, including the Khadr family, the Commission of Inquiry in the Actions of Canadian Officials in relation to Maher Arar, the case of Abdelrazik and others. Since 2015, Donna has had various roles as an executive within the Government of Canada integrity community, including with the Department of Immigration, Refugee and Citizenship, and Employment and Social Development Canada (ESDC).

Donna is currently the Executive Director with the Integrity Services Branch of ESDC, Integrity Operations, where she is overseeing the department's national enforcement and intelligence programs.
